 - ☐ Check XML (wordpad) - are these extra nodes, or not? Looks as though node heirarchy is odd.
 - ☐ Make clearer files (for diagnosis)
 - ☐ Looked at XML - /> for leaf, </node> for branch. Displaying OK. Seems to have inserted children, then main + children
- ☐ ¿ Does this happen with depth of children/siblings?
 - ☐ No - worse - all nodes pasted in as children, with all their children, recursively
- ☐ ¿ Does it work properly with just branches being pasted?
 - ☐ yes, with one and many, deep and wide branches
- ☐ Are existing branches in 'into' map affected? (assuming center is selected on 'into' map)
 - ☐ don't seem to be
- ☐ Does select all+copy differ in behaviour from select center + copy?
 - ☐ yes - behaviour exhibited with 'select all', not 'select center'
 - ☐ Need a neat bug report + example
 - ☐ **RobBug017** *Paste appears to create many duplicate nodes.*

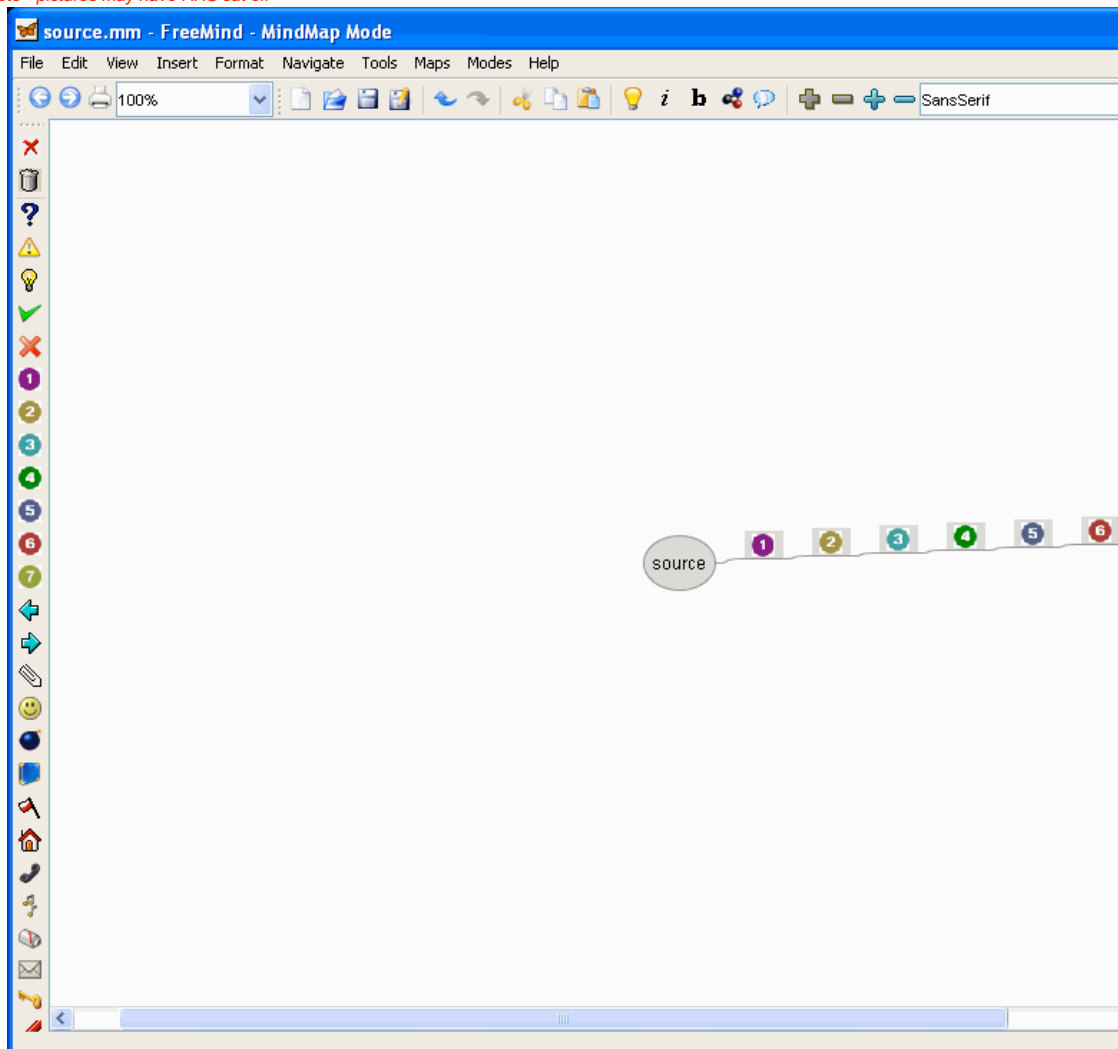
Choosing 'select all' for a map and pasting into a second map works inconsistently with copying just the centre node and pasting into a second map. In both cases, the source map is pasted in as a child of the target map.

However, in the 'select all' case, each node (at every level) in the source map is also pasted in, each with all its children - creating many duplicate nodes. See source, target before, target after maps / screenprints.

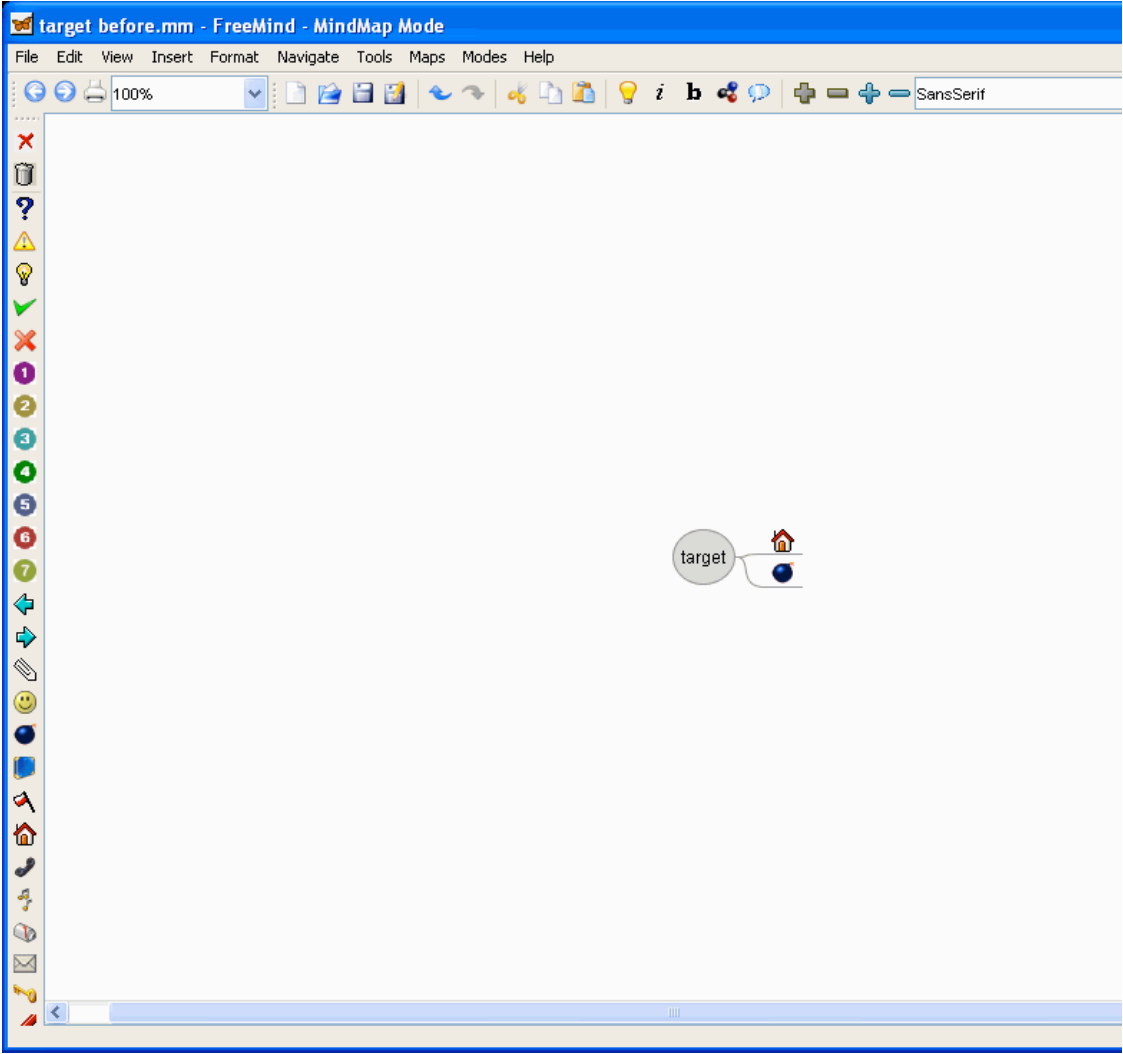
Note that copy /paste works as expected for one/many branches, and works successfully if just the central node (and not 'all') is selected. However, given the ease of access of 'select all' (has a key combination) and the undesired behaviour, this bug is very likely to cause confusion in normal use.

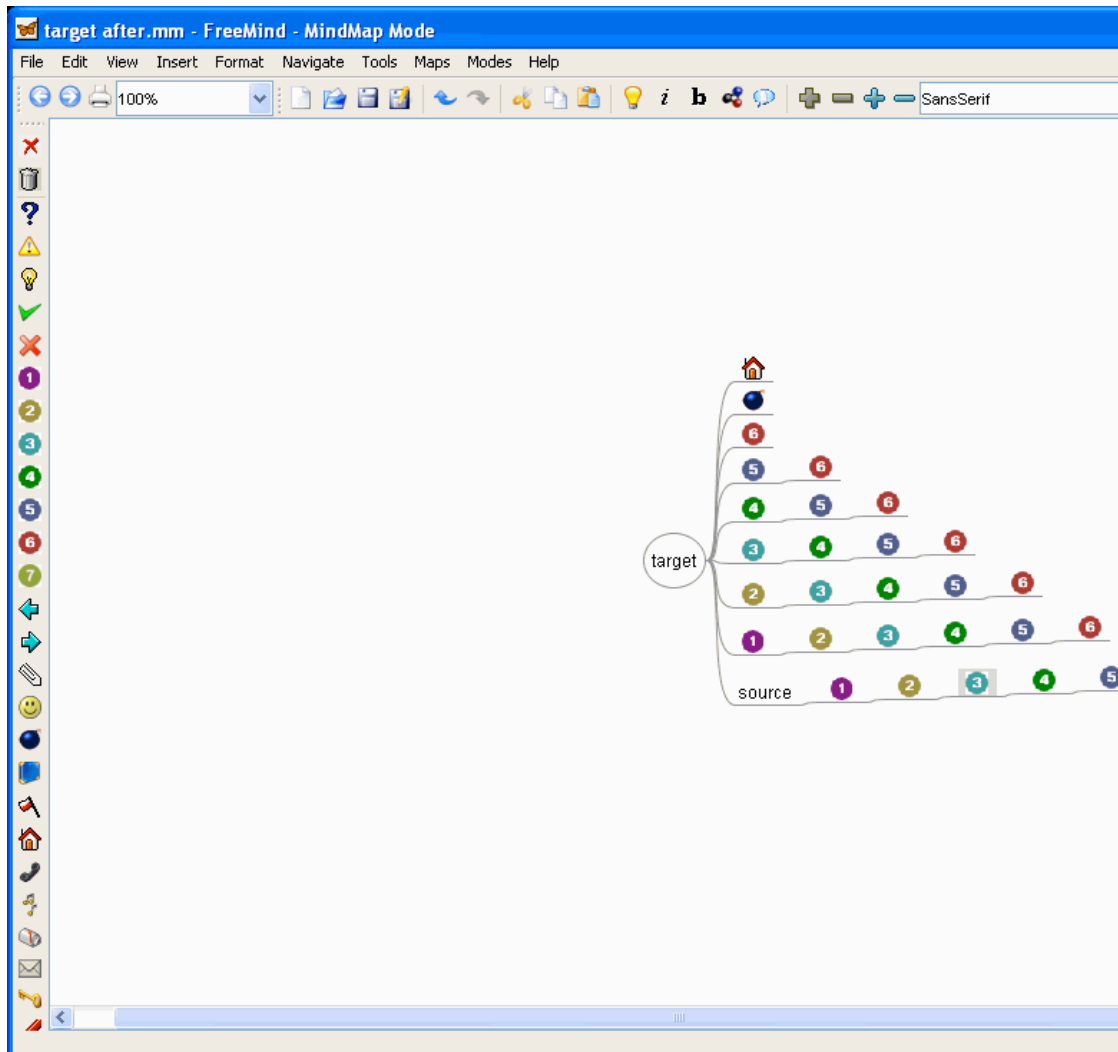
